

Within the period 22/06/2013 - 21/01/2014, Activity 43 „Information and publicity“ and Activity 42 „Achievement and testing of the cross-border network for ambient air quality monitoring“ were carried out.

Activity 42:

- The public procurement procedure for „Monitoring and Measuring Equipment for Air Pollution“ was finalized.
- The development of the web application „Interactive map related to the air pollution sources and air quality monitoring stations within Romania - Bulgaria cross border area“ was continued.
- The monitoring and measuring equipment for air pollution, needed for setting up three stations (first part of the delivery), was received.



- The program for commissioning the three stations and their related equipment that will be installed in Teleorman county was achieved.
- On 16.01.2014 ICMET Craiova participated in a working meeting at the headquarter of AEP Teleorman.

In this meeting, representatives of the Romanian Ministry of Environment and Climatic Changes, representatives of AEP Teleorman and representatives of the mayoralties from Turnu Măgurele and Zimnicea participated.
